Qualifications and By-laws
As of 2008

1. Any female between the ages of 15 and 18 years of age by the pageant date, single and presently attending Ovid-Elsie High School.
2. There will be a sponsor fee of \$40.00 to be turned in with the entry form by July 15, 2011 to Michelle Robinson, 9555 Walker Rd., Ovid. No Committee member may sponsor a candidate.
3. Candidate must send a recent picture along with the completed application and entry fee to a specified person no later than the first practice.
4. The Ovid Carriage Days Festival Queen and Court must be available for appearances at the parade in Ovid and for festival activities. The Queen and Court will also be expected to participate in at least 5 (five) other local town parades.
5. All candidates are required to participate in all rehearsals prior to the pageant.
6. Any discrepancies will be left up to the Ovid Carriage Days Festival Queen's Committee.
7. No candidate shall have a police record. Any Ovid Carriage Days Queen or Court member acquiring one will immediately relinquish her title.
8. Contestants must never have been married and must not marry while holding the title of Ovid Carriage Days Queen or Court.
9. No contestant shall be pregnant. If the Ovid Carriage Days Queen or Court member becomes pregnant during the time she is holding the title, she will relinquish her title immediately.
10. No candidate, Ovid Carriage Days Queen or Court member can be a parent.
11. No candidate may have held or presently be holding a pageant title.
12. Former Ovid Carriage Days Queens are ineligible.
13. There will be no "talent" or "bathing suit" competition. The Ovid Carriage Days Queen and her Court will be chosen for their appearance, poise, personality and communication skills.
